

# Praying in Faith

## Basics of Praying in Faith

- **Pray the Word.**

Praying in faith is based on connecting our faith to what God has already said in His Word. Essentially, we pray and stand, in faith, on Scripture. We place our full trust in God to perform His word. Hebrews 11:6 says

*“And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.” NIV*

In prayer, we command situations that are not aligned with God’s Word to come into alignment with the Word. We do not command God to do anything.

- **We pray in Jesus’ Name.**
- **We receive God’s promise by faith.**

## How to find God’s promises for any situation

Identify and document the matter you will bring before God in prayer.

Find Scriptures that specifically address your need.

Resources may include:

- ◆ Bible Index
- ◆ Bible Dictionary
- ◆ Bible Concordance
- ◆ Your Bible reading journals
- ◆ Your notes from previous teachings

## Prayer Worksheet

1. Remind God what He said about the prayers you ask in faith in Jesus' Name. (John 16:23)

*'Father you said:*

2. Remind God what He said about the necessity of your faith in Him. (Hebrews 11:6)

*"Lord, you said it is impossible for me to please you without faith in you and your word. So, I come with my faith in you."*

3. Find the specific scriptures (promise(s) in the Word) on which you are standing in faith.

Then, declare these promises. Ask God to perform His word in the life or situation about which you are praying. (See examples in *Pray America Great Again* book)

4. Tell God that you receive what He says in His Word, now, by faith.

(Hebrews 11:1, 2 Corinthians 5:7; Philippians 4:6).

5. Close with "in the Name of Jesus, Amen"
