

Guideline, Example and Worksheet for A Prayer of Faith

Essential Elements of a Prayer of Faith

- ☐ Pray the Word.
 - ✓ Connect the need to God's Word.
 - ✓ Base your faith and prayers on scripture.
- ☐ Pray in faith, by believing and trusting that God's word is true and will happen. In prayer we command situations that are not aligned with God's Word to come into alignment with the Word. We do not command God to do anything.
- ☐ Pray in Jesus' Name.
- ☐ Receive God's promise by faith.

Example Prayer of Faith

Before you begin, decide what you are going to ask God for, based on His Word.

This example asks God for the salvation of another.

Prayer Element	Example Prayer
1. Remind God what He said about the prayers you ask in faith in Jesus' Name. (John 16:23)	<i>Heavenly Father, Jesus said that if I ask you for anything in faith and in His name, you will give it to me.</i>
2. Remind God what He said about the necessity of your faith in Him. (Hebrews 11:6)	<i>Lord, you said that I need faith in you and your word to please you.</i>
3. Find the specific promise(s) in the Word on which you are standing in faith. Then declare these promises. Ask God to perform His word in the life or situation you are praying about.	<i>Father, you said that your will is that all men be saved. (1 Timothy 2:1-4) Therefore, because you said it, I pray for my friend, [Insert their name]. I ask you to remove the spiritual blindness from her (2 Corinthians 4:4) that prevents her from seeing and knowing the truth of Jesus and our critical need for salvation. Lord, you said the harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Therefore, I ask you to send someone to her today to whom she will listen and receive your truth. (Matthew 9:38; Luke 10:2)</i>
4. Tell God that, by faith, you now receive what He says in His Word. (Hebrews 11:1 and 2 Corinthians 5:7; Philippians 4:6).	<i>Lord, by faith I believe and receive what I have declared in your word and I thank you for it.</i>
5. Close with "in the Name of Jesus, Amen" (John 14:13)	<i>In the name of Jesus I pray, Amen.</i>

Prayer Element	Your Prayer
1. Remind God what He said about the prayers you ask in faith in Jesus' Name. (John 16:23)	
2. Remind God what He said about the necessity of your faith in Him. (Hebrews 11:6)	
3. Find the specific promise(s) in the Word on which you are standing in faith. Then declare these promises. Ask God to perform His word in the life or situation you are praying about.	
4. Tell God that, by faith, you now receive what He says in His Word. (Hebrews 11:1 and 2 Corinthians 5:7; Philippians 4:6).	
5. Close with "in the Name of Jesus, Amen" (John 14:13)
